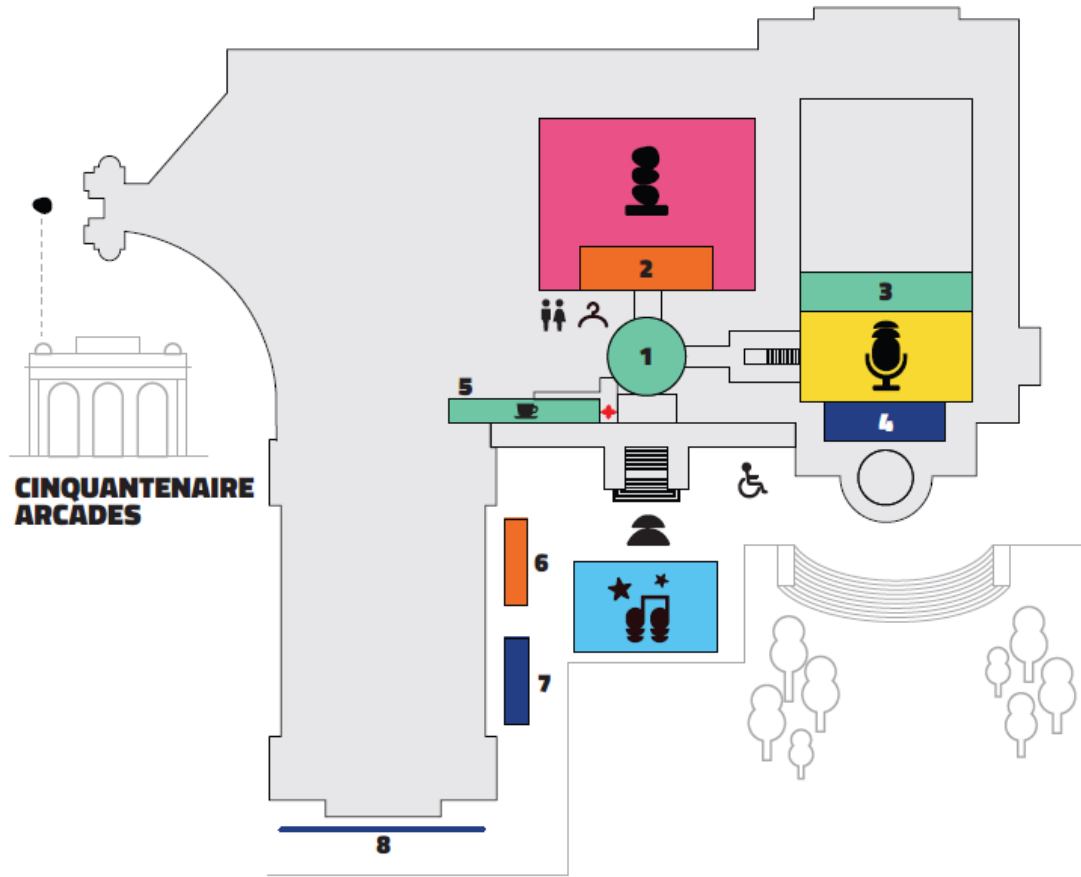

#### **By Train**

The museum is within walking distance of both Schuman and Merode stations.

#### **By Metro**

Lines 1 and 5 — stop at Schuman or Merode.

#### **By Bus**

Lines 22, 27 and 80 — stop at Gaulois

Line 61 — stop at Merode

#### **By Tram**

Line 81 — stop at Merode.

- **Parking rue des Tongres** — rue des Tongres 60, 1200 Woluwe-Saint-Lambert

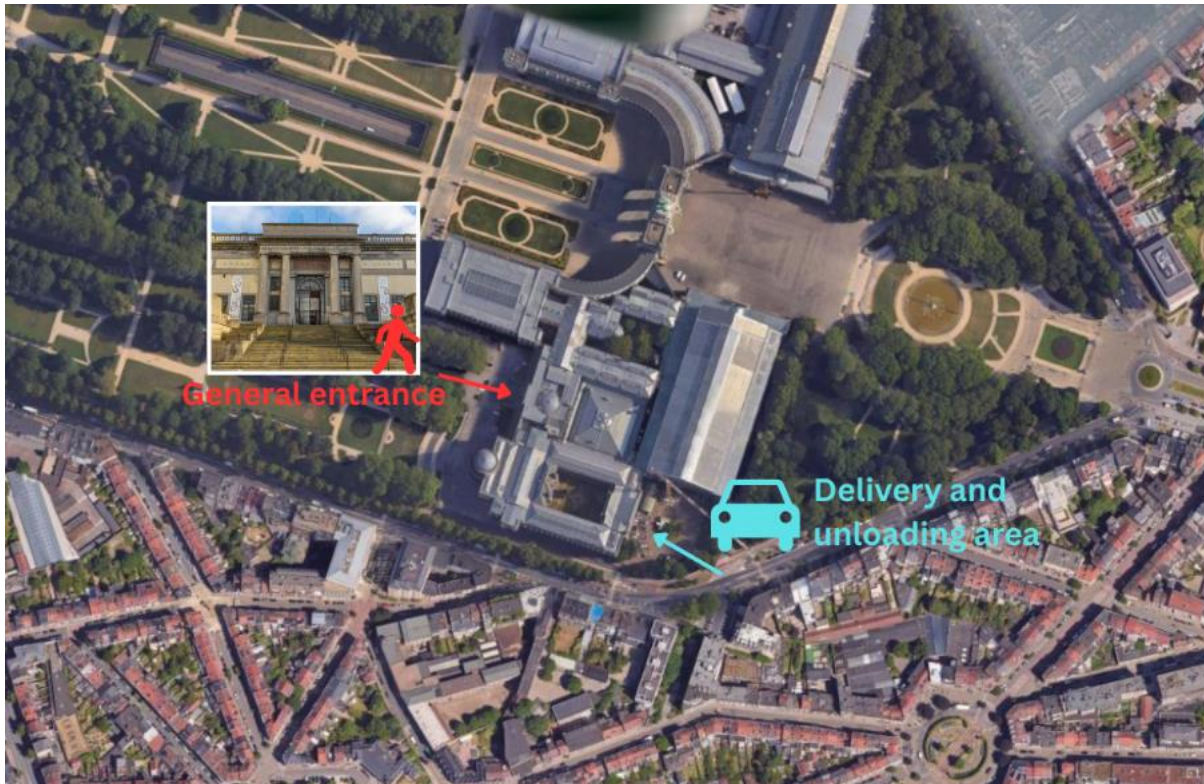

## How to get your badge?

For security reasons, all exhibitors were required to be registered by **16 May**. If you need to add additional exhibitors to your stand, please contact us as soon as possible.

Badges can be collected starting from **9 June at 10:00 AM**, outside the building, at the designated registration areas located in front of the museum entrance within the park. Please note that only registered exhibitors will be able to receive a badge and access the museum outside of official opening hours.

To quickly collect your badge, a QR code will be sent to you. You will just need to scan it at the designated kiosks.

If you are arriving later during the week, you may collect your badge directly inside the museum at the Welcome Desk.

Lockers are available for exhibitors on level -1 of the foyer of the Cour carré. You may use them to store your daily belongings. Please note that we are unable to accommodate suitcases or other large personal items.

## Lunch and Water

Lunch for **two representatives per stand**\* will be provided throughout the duration of the FAIR on **9, 10, 11 and 12 June**.

On the setup day, one representative from each stand will collect all lunch vouchers for the week at the registration desk. Please note that lost vouchers cannot be reissued, so we kindly ask you to keep them safe.

Lunch can be collected daily in exchange for a voucher between **12:00 PM and 3:00 PM** at the designated tent outside, on the right side of the museum. Please ensure one person stays at your stand at all times.

In line with the values of the NEB Festival, several water fountains will be available throughout the venue. We strongly encourage you to **bring your own refillable water bottle** and make use of these stations. Please note that bottled water will not be distributed onsite.

*\* For projects whose stands have been merged with another project, only **one exhibitor per project** will be entitled to lunch covered by the organisation.*

## Photos and Videos

If you plan to take photos or videos at your stand, please note that the organiser, the European Commission, refers to the privacy statement made available in the registration form. Participants have been informed that photos and videos will be taken during the Festival and may be used during and after the event.

The European Commission is not responsible for any photos, video recordings, or other visual content produced by third parties, nor for any use made of such content once it is publicly accessible.

Third parties remain fully responsible for ensuring that the capture, processing, and dissemination of images or recordings comply with applicable data protection legislation and image rights requirements.

Please note that individuals wearing a **“No Photos” badge and a red lanyard** must not be photographed or included in any identifiable way in content intended for public use.

## Your stand

We will provide you with a ready-made stand to display and present your products and services. Two exhibition stand sizes are available: 1.5x3m or 1.5x6m space and three different types of stands are available.

Please note that final sizes allocation has been communicated to you (*Appendix B*).

You will be provided with the following:

- A solid back wall and two open side panels
- Electricity (16A, 220V) + Power strip
- 3 Overhead lights
- One high table and two highchairs- *If you requested any changes to the furniture or made additional requests, we have confirmed by email what will be included on your stand.*
- One screen 55" + HDMI cable
- Wifi
- Signage: Your project title will be printed and displayed above your stand.

## Screens:

- Video formats supported by the screens:
  - AVI
  - MP4
  - MPG/MPEG
- Possible to connect a USB Key.
- One HDMI cable will be available on each screen
- All provided screens will have the sound disabled to avoid overlapping audio playback, but you will be allowed to use headphones

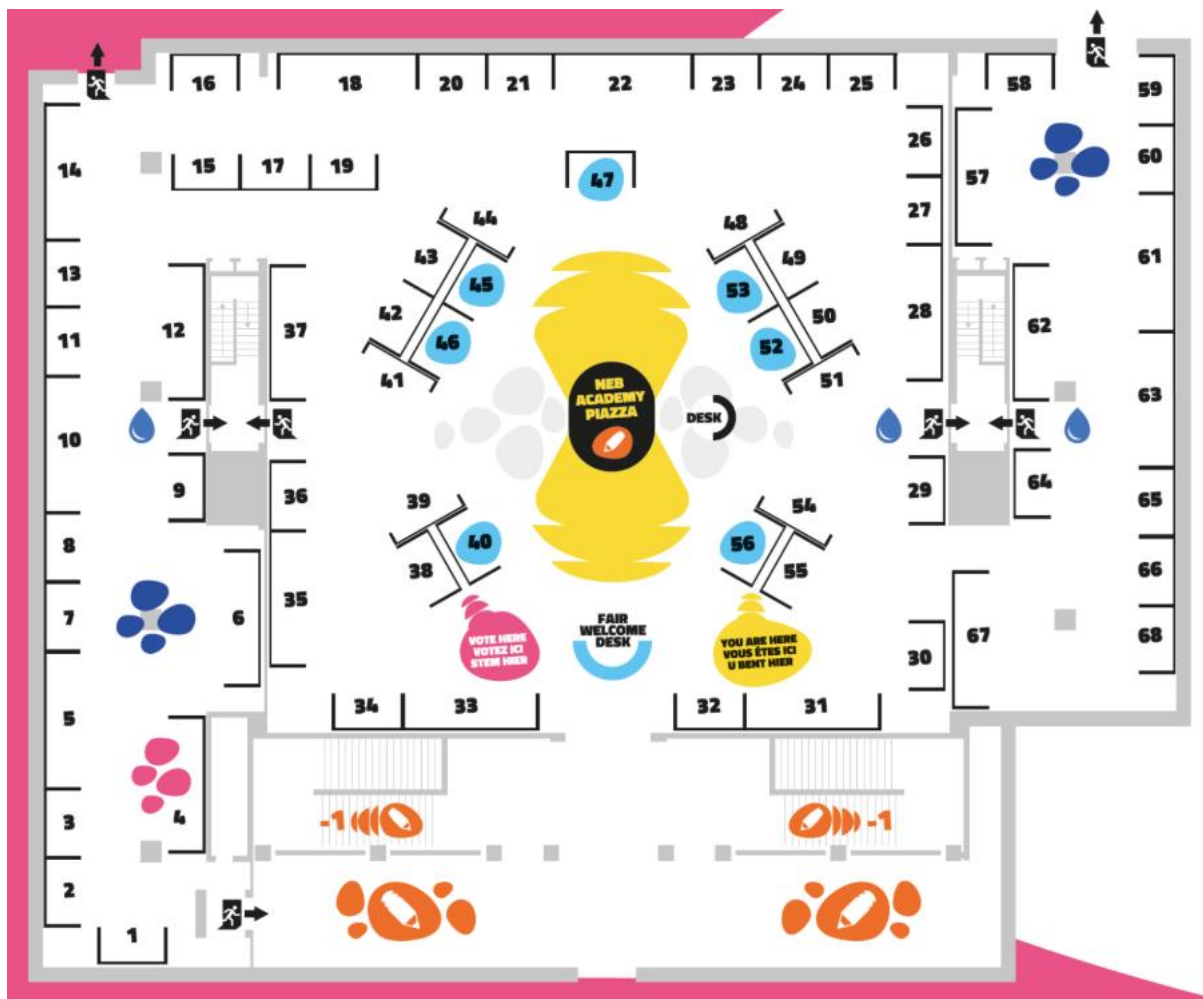
**You are responsible for the content displayed on the screens.** We will not collect your presentations or videos in advance, nor will we be responsible for uploading them to your screen.

It is therefore your responsibility to bring the necessary equipment and ensure that the content is provided in the accepted formats mentioned above.

## Wall:

- Materials may be displayed on the walls; however, drilling or screwing items **into the walls is strictly forbidden.**
- Pins or adhesive (**using gaffer tape** at least as a first layer directly on the wooden surface) may be used. **You shall bring your own material.**

## Shipping and returning of materials

It is not permitted to send parcels directly to the museum. We have provided you with the procedure to follow should you need to send any parcels.

**Please note that shipping costs are not covered by us and the parcels need to arrive before 5/06.**

You plan to bring your material by car?

If you need to unload upon arrival on the installation day (09/06) or on the dismantling day (12/06), **you should have informed us in advance**. If this is not the case, please contact us as soon as possible. Please note that you will need to unload and then move your vehicle to park outside the museum. Due to limited space, we need to ensure a rotation system and therefore cannot allow vehicles to remain parked for more than 30 minutes.

This Closing Ceremony will be followed by a drink's reception to which all Fair exhibitors are warmly invited.
