Pritzker Prize-winning Architect, Shigeru Ban was born in Tokyo in 1957. Graduated from the Cooper Union, New York. Founded Shigeru Ban Architects in 1985, now work with three offices in Tokyo, Paris and New York. Became consultant to the United Nations High Commissioner for Refugees (UNHCR) in 1995. Established the NGO, Voluntary Architects' Network (VAN) in the same year to support disaster relief. Recipient of multiple awards, including Le Grade de Commandeur for L'Ordre des Arts et des Lettres, France (2014), Pritzker Architecture Prize (2014), Medal of Honor with Purple Ribbon, Japan (2017) and Mother Teresa Social Justice Award (2017). Specially Appointed Professor at International Research Institute of Disaster Science, Tohoku University, since 2020. Currently Professor at Kyoto University of Art and Design, also at Keio University.

Selected works include Centre Pompidou - Metz (France, 2010), Tamedia New Office Building (Switzerland, 2013) Cardboard Cathedral (New Zealand, 2013), Oita Prefectural Art Museum (Japan, 2015), Mt. Fuji World Heritage Centre, Shizuoka (Japan, 2017), La Seine Musicale (France, 2017), and Swatch Omega Headquarters (Switzerland, 2019).
