Employee of the Polish National Institute of Architecture and Urban Planning. Teacher at the Faculty of Civil Engineering and Architecture at the Lublin University of Technology. Author of more than 200 texts on architecture for *Architektura-murator*, a Polish architectural monthly, *A10 New European architecture*, *Architectural Design*, *MARK*, *ERA 21*, *Autoportret* and other magazines and websites.

Nominating expert for the European Union Prize for Contemporary Architecture Mies van der Rohe Award (editions 2015, 2019, 2022). Member of the jury at numerous architectural competitions including European and the competition for the best architectural projects and implementations in Lithuania in the years 2008-2009 organized by the Lithuanian Society of Architects.

Member of the Municipal Committee for Architecture and Town Planning of the City of Warsaw. 2010-2018: Member of the Municipal Committee for Architecture and Town Planning of the City of Lublin. Member of the Society of Polish Architects SARP.
